The regular meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M., at the Township Hall, 12102 S.R. 725 West, Germantown, Ohio, by Board President Randy Benson with the Pledge of Allegiance. Trustees Randy R. Benson, Gregory A. Hanahan, Benjamin F. DeGroat, and Fiscal Officer Robert W. Rohrbach Jr. were present. Police Chief W. L. Wilcox, Road & Service Superintendent Jeremy Holbrook, and Zoning Inspector Laurie Rohrbach were also present.

This meeting was audio tape recorded and the CD is on file.

The Germantown Press, Dayton Daily News, and Middletown Journal were notified of the meeting.

NUISANCE ABATEMENT HEARING -

- I. Mrs. Rohrbach requested a Nuisance Abatement Hearing for the Delotell Property located at 12577 Harris Rd., Parcel ID D14-00902-0022.
- II. At 7:01 PM, Mr. Benson introduced a MOTION, seconded by Mr. Hanahan, to open a nuisance abatement hearing on the Delotell Property located at 12577 Harris Rd., Parcel ID D14-00902-0022.

Mrs. Rohrbach was sworn in and presented the facts of the case. She explained that there debris, garbage and junk in the yard. She present pictures of the property as evidence. - IV. Chief Wilcox requested that the Board consider placing a street light at the entrance to the Township Hall from SR 725. The Board requested that the Chief obtain quotes from Miami Valley Lighting.
- V. Chief Wilcox requested an executive session prior to the end of the meeting to discuss a personnel matter.

ROAD/SERVICE DEPARTMENT REPORT –

- I. Mr. Holbrook updated the Board on the Friend Rd. Issue II Phase 1B project. The project is complete and being closed out. He present disbursement forms for signature by the Board.
