The German Township Road and Service Department does more than patch potholes and plow snow. The Department maintains all aspects of the 75.165 lane miles of roads within the Township, along with all other Township owned property. Below is a list of just some of the many items that the Service Department is responsible for.

ROADS AND STREETS-

- Plowing and salting roads in the winter.
- Repairing potholes and broken pavement.
- Administrating contracts and inspection for roadwork done by outside forces.
 - Paving
 - Striping
 - Chip Seal
 - Crack Seal
 - OPWC Issue II Projects
- Repairing and/ or replacing damaged/ worn road signs.
- Maintaining gravel shoulders along roadway.
- Ditch and waterway maintenance/ and improvements.
- Drainage culvert maintenance and replacement.
- Mowing and trimming of road right of way.
- Trimming trees along roadway.
- Guardrail maintenance and repair.
- Removal of animals that have been struck on and along the roadway.
- Spraying noxious weeds within right of way.

EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE-

- Maintenance on all Road Department equipment.
- Perform routine maintenance on all Township Police cruisers.
- Assemble specifications and bid documents for new equipment purchases.

TOWNSHIP CEMETERIES (5 inactive cemeteries)-

- Mow and trim grass.
- Trim and/ or remove trees within cemetery.
- Repair broken/ damaged head stones.
- Maintain cemetery fences.

TOWNSHIP BUILDING AND GROUNDS-

- Mow and trim grass
- Maintain plantings and beds surrounding the building.
- Plow parking lot and clear sidewalks during winter.
- Maintain/ repair all aspects of Township buildings (Mtg. room, Police Dept., Zoning, & Trash)
